There are no restrictions regarding size or media, except that the work has to be created in the past year and must hold a place of significance for the creator. This importance must be explained in a short video clip (max. 90 sec.) accompanying the main submission.

The deadline for all submissions is November 18th, 2022.

By then, your submission, must be uploaded as digital files (JPG, MP3, MP4) to our online platform Submittable.

To do all this, non-digital entries, whether paintings, sculptures, drawings, objects etc. must be photographed from different angles in high resolution (300 dpi).

Digital artworks (photo, film, new media, Snapchat, TikTok, etc.) as well as audio files can be uploaded directly to Submittable following the link on our website.

Only 1 submission please (instead of 3 works in the previous competitions).
